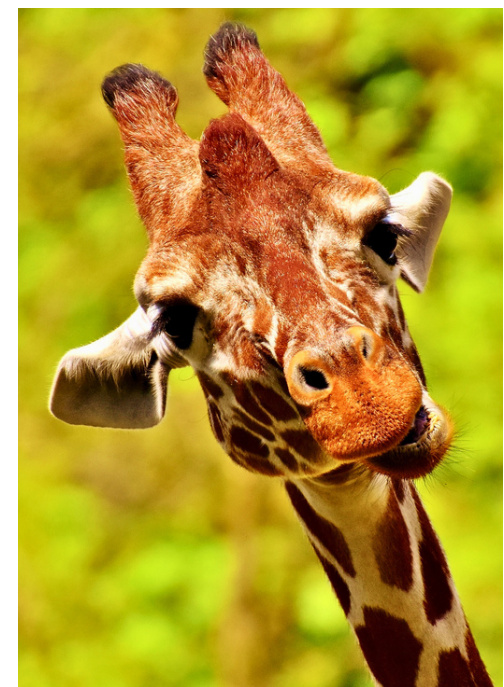
MILLENNIUM PARK
